8. PARENTAL RELOCATION *(moving with the Tribal Youth)*

Notice Requirement

If the person with whom the Tribal Youth resides with plans on relocating, that person must provide notice to everyone who has Court-ordered time with the Tribal Youth. Information protected by Court Order may be withheld, and a relocating person may ask the Court to waive notice if providing it would put someone's health or safety at risk. Failure to provide notice may result in sanctions, including contempt.

Notice must be given at least 60 days before the planned move. If the required information was not known in time, and delaying the move is not reasonable, notice must be given within **5 days** of learning the information.

The notice must include:

- An address for official correspondence during the objection period.
- A brief statement of the specific reasons for the move.
- A statement that the other parent or guardian may object, including this required language:
(The relocation of the Tribal Youth will be permitted and the proposed revised residential schedule may be confirmed unless, within 30 days, you file a Petition and Motion with the Court to block the relocation or object to the proposed revised residential schedule.)

Include the following: *(if available)*

- The new residence address, or at least the city and state.
- The new mailing address, if different.
- The new home telephone number.
- The name and address of the new school or daycare, if applicable.
- The date of the planned move.
- A proposed parenting plan with a revised visitation or residential schedule.

Note: *The relocating person must promptly update the notice as soon as new information becomes available.*

FAILURE TO PROVIDE NOTICE

The Court may grant a Temporary Order restraining relocation of the Tribal Youth (*or ordering return of the Tribal Youth if the Tribal Youth's relocation has occurred*) if the Court finds:

1. The required notice of an intended relocation of the Tribal Youth was not provided in a timely manner and the non-relocating party was substantially prejudiced;
2. The relocation of the Tribal Youth has occurred without agreement of the parties, Court Order, or the notice required; or
3. After examining evidence presented at a hearing for temporary orders in which the parties had adequate opportunity to prepare and be heard, there is a likelihood that on final hearing the Court will not approve the intended relocation of the Tribal Youth or no circumstances exist sufficient to warrant a relocation of the Tribal Youth prior to a final determination at trial.

Right to Object

A person entitled to time with the Tribal Youth under a Court order can file an objection to the Tribal Youth's relocation whether or not he or she received proper notice. The objection must be served on all persons entitled to time with the Tribal Youth. The relocating person shall not move the Tribal Youth during the time for objection unless: **(a)** the delayed notice provisions apply; or **(b)** a Court order allows the move.

Except for good cause shown, if a person entitled to object to the relocation of the Tribal Youth does not file an objection with the Court within **30 days** after receipt of the relocation notice, then the relocation of the Tribal Youth may be permitted. A non-objecting person may be entitled to the residential time or visitation with the Tribal Youth specified in the Proposed Residential Schedule included with the relocation notice. Any person entitled to residential time or visitation with a Tribal Youth under a Court Order retains his or her right to move for modification.

Move within Same School District

When the intended relocation of the Tribal Youth is within the school district in which the Tribal Youth currently reside the majority of the time, the person intending to relocate the Tribal Youth may provide actual notice by any reasonable means to every other person entitled to residential time or visitation with the Tribal Youth under a Court Order.

A person who is entitled to residential time or visitation with the Tribal Youth under a Court Order may not object to the intended relocation of the Tribal Youth within the school district in which the Tribal Youth currently reside the majority of the time, but he or she retains the right to move for modification.

RESIDENTIAL SCHEDULE
