The emphasis of Decolonization is to assure that Chickaloon Village achieves sovereignty and self-governance. The focus areas seeks to educate individuals and the community to transform understanding and perspective on sovereignty rights and responsibilities of indigenous people. The result of this focus area is to regain responsibility to manage resources on a sustainable basis.

Responsibility

The emphasis of Responsibility is to assure that we are actively engaged in our duty to protect and enrich our community, environment, culture, food sources, traditions and Ahtna language. The focus area seeks to nurture community and environmental wellness and foster sustainability and self-sufficiency. The result of the focus area Responsibility is the protection of the environment, sustainable use of resources, and cultivation of an educated and respectful community.

ts'ilk'ey kezlaen Connections

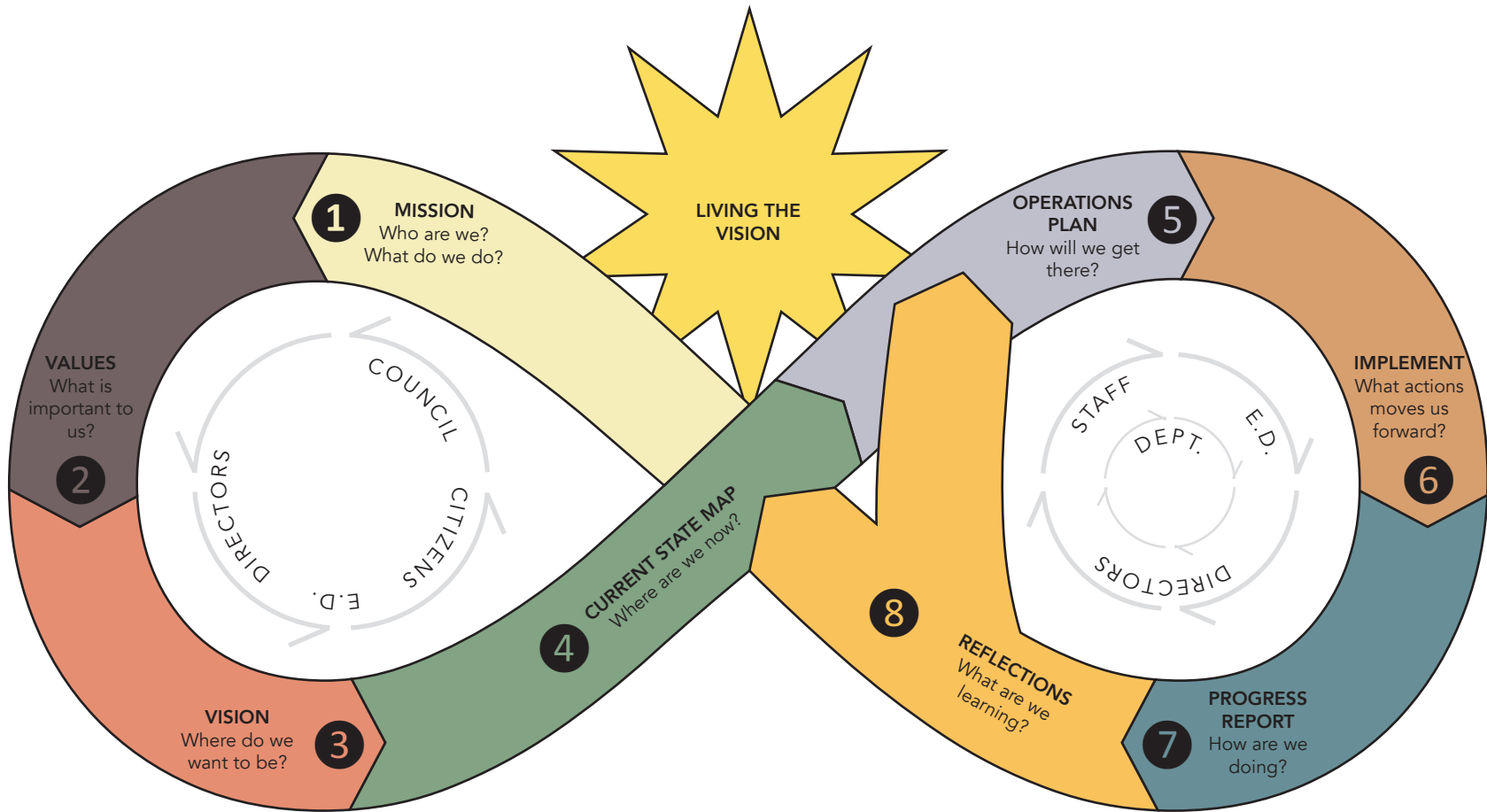
